In may places worship has turned out nothing but concert and entertainment while God gets pushed out of the picture and the death of Jesus is just words.

"For we are not like many, peddling the word of God, but as from sincerity, but as from God, we speak in Christ in the sight of God." (II Corinthians 2:17)

There are many 'peddlers' around us. They love attention, money and even holding to a form of godliness while denying the power (II Timothy 3:5). Paul calls them corrupt, empty and deceivers. The result? **AVOID SUCH MEN AS THESE!**
