Heart to Heart...

"But if anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, he does not belong to Him." (Romans 8:9) Very simple and plain. There are no ways to try to discern this. It is plain as can be. God is holy. Christ Jesus is holy. The Spirit is holy so the first thing that is a must is placing your faith in being made holy at baptism by the blood of Christ. Once we realize that, the promise of The Spirit becomes a reality.

"For all who are being led by the Spirit of God, these are sons of God." (Romans 8:14) We must have the Spirit to belong and then must yield to His Spirit as His child. It's not a 'fuzzy' feeling or something that makes you tingle. The Spirit can't be felt. He is a promise. People gather and speak against a preacher from the lessons they have heard. Or they speak against the elders for decisions or maybe they believe they have a better idea of what elders should be doing. Or they speak against another one of God's Spirit promised people. GOSSIP! Who is leading one to do this?

What really counts? I must have the Spirit to belong to God and then I must allow the Spirit to lead me into the very nature of God. Think about it!!!
