

Please listen to the audio lesson “A Letter from Jesus: Laodicea” first. Then after finishing the audio lesson, have the Scriptures handy to best utilize the following questions to answer and consider thoughtfully for your further study.

A Letter from Jesus: Laodicea

1. Read Revelation 3:21-22

- a. What is Jesus’ promise to the overcomer (faithful saints) in Laodicea?
- b. Was Jesus already sitting with His Father on the throne?
- c. Does Jesus know how to overcome by experience? When did He?
- d. Who must we imitate to overcome & sit on the throne with Jesus?

2. Read Revelation 4:1-11

- a. What is this whole chapter describing?
- b. What do you glean from seeing this picture of the throne room of God?
- c. Who all is interacting in this scene?
- d. The living creatures are full of eyes (they truly behold God), what do they continually proclaim about Him? Why would they?
- e. By beholding the throne, what is stirred within the four living creatures & the 24 elders?
- f. Why do they see The Father (our Lord & our God) as WORTHY?

3. Read Revelation 5:1-14

- a. What is this whole chapter showing?
- b. Was anyone initially found who was WORTHY? Where did they look?
- c. Where does this “Overcomer” stand? When did He become WORTHY?
- d. What made the four living creatures & the 24 elders change their song?
- e. In verse 10, what is the promise to those who have been made (by the blood of the Lamb) a kingdom & priests?
- f. The angels, living creatures, and elders are all around what?
- g. Why is the Lamb WORTHY?
- h. Every created thing addresses Him who sits on the throne, what is said?

4. Read Revelation 6:15-17

- a. Why are all these “great” men, “the rich”, & “the kings” hiding?
- b. Who do they fear? Why can they not stand against Him?

Thoughts to Consider: Have you ever wanted to see the throne room of God? He wants us to understand. John wrote down all that he saw (Rev. 1:11). Those who are full of eyes see that the Lord God is HOLY, LORD, ALMIGHTY, & ETERNAL. And all who behold are stirred to worship Him. When Jesus gave His life, and was resurrected He then became worthy, like none other. And with His blood He purchased the sinners who turned to faith, making us a kingdom (He is the King) & priests (He is to be Worshipped). And all other “great” men, rich, & kings of the earth, beg to hid from the Wrath of the Lamb & He who sits on the throne. The overcomer will sit with HIM on HIS THRONE (3:21) and reign with Him (5:10)!

5. Read Revelation 7:13-17

- a. How were their robes made white?
- b. What are they “doing” before the throne of God?
- c. What will “He who sits on the throne” spread over them?
- d. How will that affect them as they serve day & night?
- e. Who is in the center of the throne? What is He actively doing?

6. Read the verse(s) below, and learn more about THE LORD AT HIS THRONE:

- a. Revelation 8:3 / What & where are the prayers of the SAINTS?
- b. Revelation 14:3-5 / Who purchased them? Did their lifestyle matter?
- c. Revelation 16:17 / Who decided when “It is Done”?
- d. Revelation 19:4-6 / Seeing God on the throne stirs worship, why?
- e. Revelation 20:11-12 / Are the created heavens & earth eternal?
Does lifestyle & heeding the voice of Jesus matter before the throne?
Can your deeds cause your name to be erased from the book of life?
- f. Revelation 21:3-8 / Who is speaking? What is changing for the saints?
What can the one sitting on the throne make all things? True?
Who will inherit these things? Lifestyle matter?
- g. Revelation 22:1-5 / Whose throne is it now?
What is found at the throne? What do His bond-servants do?
Who will illumine them? How long will they reign with Him?

Final Thoughts: Reigning with Christ is about our willingness to humbly submit to His will. Our prayers are a soothing aroma before the throne. Our lifestyle matters for eternity! Seeing His throne should stir worship & a life that imitates the KING!
