After listening to the recording, please read Malachi 2:1-9 again. Below are some questions to meditate on and to consider, remembering the verses from Malachi.

Question #1:

Why did priests have such a great influence in Israel?

What enables God's people (priests; 1 Peter 2:9) to have influence on worldly souls?

Question #2:

Why does God curse His people who refuse to honor His commandments from their heart?

What happened in life while refusing to honor His known commands?

Does it effect your children (offspring) also?

Question #3:

God's rebuke of Israel was very nasty, but was it just? Why?

Question #4:

When God's people stand in awe of His Name to revere Him, God gives them life & peace.

Think of 2 examples of this from the Old Testament & 2 from the New Testament.

Question #5:

In the New Testament, all who are washed by the blood of the Lamb are priests.

How do we show ourselves as God's Messengers with our mouth, lips, & how we walk?

Question #6:

How far would the Lord let His people go when they no longer took His commands to heart?

What sparked God to send Malachi?

Question #7:

Compare Malachi 2:5 with Romans 8:6. What did/does God want His People to possess?

What will separate us from these?

Question #8:

Does the Old Covenant promote or stand for partiality?

Does Jesus promote or stand for partiality in the New Covenant?

What is the outcome of partial priests in the Old/New Covenant?
