

Malachi Class #4

After listening to the recording, please read Malachi 2:10-17 again. Below are some questions to meditate on and to consider, remembering the verses from Malachi.

Question #1:

When you come to faith that God is your Creator, what reassurances do you realize?

Question #2:

When God is not honored in your life, what relationship(s) will be affected?

Question #3:

What is God's response to those who offer insincere offerings/sacrifices to Him?
Why does God desire sacrifices that honor Him? Who gains from them?

Question #4:

Many souls weep tears of sorrow, but what moves the heart of God to intercede? Why?
(See 2 Corinthians 7:8-10)

Question #5:

How does the Lord stand up for the holy wife (or husband) who is betrayed by their mate?
Will God ever defend those who are actively defiant? Does God's witness/testimony matter?

Question #6:

What is the difference between "the Spirit" and "your spirit"? Can they work together?
Can they work in opposition to each other? Who gets to decide? What is the outcome?

Question #7:

If you are married, what is an area you can improve in honoring God that will help your marriage relationship?

Question #8:

We know that "God is Love" (1 John 4:16) & that God divorced Israel & Judah (Jeremiah 3:8).
Can divorce be motivated by godly love? How?

Question #9:

Why is God alone qualified to execute justice? (John 8:7)
How can we ever rightfully execute justice? (John 5:30)
What can make our judgments flawed?
