After listening to the recording, please read Malachi 3:8-18 again. Below are some questions to meditate on and to consider, remembering the verses from Malachi.

Question #1:

What's wrong with the heart of worshippers who cluelessly rob God? Can we do the same?

Question #2:

God did not require tithes & offerings to fill a needed void, so why curse the robbers?
Is the Lord just in cursing those who rob Him?

Question #3:

The Lord promised "Return to Me and I will return to you."
Had the Lord already decided how He would respond to those who returned?
Do we ever consider what the Lord has planned for us, should we honor & return to Him?

Question #4:

When God blesses those who fear & honor Him, what does He change that we are powerless to change?

Question #5:

How can the outsider (nations) tell when God has blessed a family? Marriage? Children?

Question #6:

What is the mindset of the religious & arrogant toward serving the Lord?
Can they find others who agree & encourage them toward death's curse?

Question #7:

How does the Lord respond toward those who fear the Lord & esteem His Name?
Has God already planned how He will bless them, before they turn to Him?
Make an application from Matthew 7:13-14.

Question #8:

God will spare His children who serve Him. How does it change your outlook when you encounter difficulties know the Lord claims you as His own Special Treasure?

Question #9:

What distinction is hidden from those who refuse to fear the Lord & esteem His Name?
What does it take for them to realize it's been hidden?
Did the Israelites know they were robbers? How did they figure it out?
How will we figure it out too?
