

Malachi Class #7

After listening to the recording, please read Malachi 3:16 - 4:6 again. Below are some questions to meditate on and to consider, remembering the verses from Malachi.

Question #1:

Thinking back on the entire book of Malachi, what all was lost in Israel when they decided to no longer honor and respect the Lord of hosts?

Question #2:

After studying the book of Malachi, why was the message of "My Messenger" (Malachi) fitting to be the last communication of God recorded until New Testament times? Is God wise?

Question #3:

What is the major difference between how God responds to all the arrogant and evil doers verses those who revere and fear His Name?

When the fire hits would you rather be chaff (4:1) or metal (3:2-3)

Who gets to make those everyday choices?

Question #4:

Compare Malachi 4:2 with Luke 1:76-79. What parallels do you see comparing "the sun of righteousness will rise with healing in its wings" and Zacharias' prophecy in Luke 1?

Question #5:

How could there be a day of the Lord that is both Great & Terrible? What's the point?

Question #6:

Is Jesus ever mistaken for Elijah the prophet or John the Baptist? [Mark 6:14-16]

How confused was Herod? Did Jesus ever reveal who John the Baptist was? [Matt. 11:7-15]

Question #7:

What did Gabriel tell Zacharias about his future son's life & lifestyle? [Luke 1:14-17]

Should we strive to be forerunner's for Jesus now, since He will return again?

Question #8:

In Malachi 4:6, what would be the deciding factor of whether or not the Lord would come & smite the land with a curse? Should fathers be concerned? Should children be concerned?

Question #9:

In Genesis thru Malachi, a major point is "the Messiah is COMING". In Matthew thru John, a major point is "the Messiah is HERE". In Acts thru Revelation, "the Messiah is coming BACK". What was the key of God's people being ready or not? Are you now ready for Jesus' return?
