

After listening to the recording of Class #11 of our continuing study of First Thessalonians, use the following questions to further your study and find application within our own lives. Read the Scriptures first, then consider the questions that follow.

### **First Thessalonians Class #11**

#### **#1. Read John 5:24-29**

- A. What determines if you have Eternal Life? What has he/she passed out of?
- B. When Jesus says, “the (spiritually) dead will hear the voice of the Son of God,” who we be the ones who live? Is “hearing” just audible sound or a change of behavior?
- C. The Son of Man has authority to execute what?
- D. In the end, how many will raise from physical death?
- E. Name the two types of resurrection that are mentioned in verse 29.
- F. What determines the type of resurrection that will happen to you?

#### **#2. Read 1 Corinthians 15:1-8**

- A. What four actions are mentioned with the Gospel in the first two verses?
- B. What determines if we retain/keep our salvation by the Gospel?
- C. How does Paul describe the aspects of the Gospel in verses 3-4?
- D. How important is the Gospel in the life of the saints?
- E. How many eye-witnesses were there of Jesus after His resurrection?
- F. Have you ever doubted the resurrection of Jesus? What convicted you of its truth?

#### **#3. Read 1 Corinthians 15:12-19, 29-34**

- A. Had some in Corinth left the truth of the Gospel?
- B. If Christ was not raised, what all is affected? What about our sins?
- C. If Christ didn't raise, what would be the outcome for those who have “fallen asleep”?
- D. Was Paul's life ever in danger for the sake of teaching the resurrection of Jesus?
- E. What happens to our character (morals) when we lose sight of the resurrection?

#### **#4. Read 1 Corinthians 15:42-44, 50-58**

- A. List the differences between our earthly/perishable & eternal/imperishable bodies?
- B. What can't inherit the kingdom of God? So, what will not be there? Change needed?
- C. How quickly will we all be changed? How did Jesus take away the “sting” of death?
- D. Why does the Victory come through our Lord Jesus Christ?
- E. Since we know these things concerning the resurrection when the Lord returns, How does this affect our behavior now in Jesus?
- F. How awesome will it be to have an imperishable/eternal body raised in power & glory that is prepared to inherit the Kingdom of God & to be with Jesus forever?
